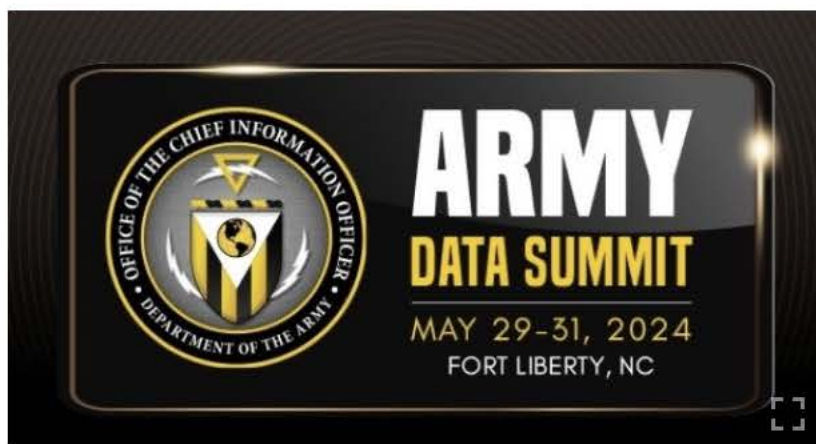


The Inaugural Army Data Summit 2024: Operationalizing Data Centricity and Decision-Making
